WHO IS THE PROGRAMME FOR?

The Level 3 Certificate in Dementia Care is aimed at those who are already working in care roles with individuals with dementia. This qualification offers an engaging programme where learners can extend their knowledge and understanding. The qualification is available for learners aged 19 and over.

HOW LONG IS THE PROGRAMME?

The programme is delivered over a period of 5 months.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

The programme is delivered entirely in the workplace on a one to one basis by your own dedicated assessor who meets with you face to face every month to provide individualised support. This includes teaching, training, assessment and regular reviews of your progress with you and your manager. In between visits learners will be expected to complete work to ensure progress is made as a result of attendance at workshops. The aim of the programme is for you to apply the new skills that you learn to improve your performance in the workplace.



WHAT QUALIFICATIONS WILL I ACHIEVE AT THE END?

At the end of the programme you will achieve a Level 3 Certificate in Dementia Care.

This covers the following:

course units

Mandatory - 4 units (15 credits)

- These units cover areas such as:
- Understand the process and experience of Dementia
- Enable rights and choices of individuals with Dementia whilst minimising risks
- Understand and enable interaction and communication with individuals who have Dementia
- Equality, Diversity and Inclusion in Dementia Care practice

Additional Units - (6 credits)

These units cover areas such as:

- Understand the administration of medication to individuals with Dementia using a person-centred approach
- Understand and meet the nutritional requirements of individuals with Dementia
- Contribute to support of positive risk-taking for individuals
