WHO IS THE PROGRAMME FOR?

The Level 3 Certificate in End of Life Care is relevant to people working in health and social care settings where individuals, who are supported, are approaching the end of their lives. This may include health residential, domiciliary, care and palliative care.

HOW LONG IS THE PROGRAMME?

The programme is delivered over a period of 5 months.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

The programme is delivered entirely in the workplace on a one to one basis by your own dedicated assessor who meets with you face to face every month to provide individualised support. This includes teaching, training, assessment and regular reviews of your progress with you and your manager. The aim of the programme is for you to apply the new skills that you learn to improve your performance in the workplace.



WHAT QUALIFICATIONS WILL I ACHIEVE AT THE END?

At the end of the programme you will achieve a Level 3 Certificate in End of Life Care.

This covers the following:

course units

Mandatory - 5 units (17 credits)

These units cover areas such as:

- Understand how to provide support
- Managing symptoms
- Understand advance care planning
- Supporting individuals with loss and grief
- Support individuals with specific communication needs

Additional Units - (9 credits)

These units cover areas such as:

- Contribute to the care of a deceased person
- · Support individuals who are distressed
- Provide support to manage pain and discomfort
- Understand how to support individuals during the last days of life
- Support individuals at the end of life
- Work with families, carers and individuals during times of crisis
- · Support individuals during the last days of life
