The Level 3 Diploma in Adult Care is an occupational qualification for learners who work in Adult Care Settings, where you have key responsibilities for delivery of care and support and/or a level of supervisory responsibility for others. Covering essential concepts in modern care, including the duty of care, safeguarding and protection, strategies for promoting well-being and techniques for special individual needs, this course will prepare you for a wide range of roles in healthcare.

How we deliver this qualification

This qualification is delivered on a one to one, or remote, basis by your own dedicated expert Health and Social Care Tutor.

They will meet with you every month (face to face or virtually) to provide teaching and training to help you develop new knowledge and skills and guide you through the programme.

They will then assess your competence by observing you applying the new skills at work and helping you develop a portfolio of evidence to prove you have met the requirements of the qualification.
